STATEMENT FOLLOWING DR MALUSI GIGABA'S COURT APPEARANCE IN THE IDAC MATTER

Attorney Nicholas Kourie, legal representative for Dr Malusi Gigaba, confirms that the Gauteng High Court today allocated 23 October as the next court date in the matter involving Dr Gigaba and his co-accused.

Today's proceedings mark the conclusion of an important phase in the Court's case management process and provide clarity regarding the next stage of the judicial proceedings.

The defence welcomes the procedural certainty provided by the allocation of the next court appearance date and will continue preparing its case in accordance with the directions of the Court.

Attorney Nicholas Kourie said:

"The allocation of the next court appearance date provides certainty regarding the way forward. The defence remains committed to the judicial process and will continue preparing thoroughly for the proceedings in accordance with the Court's directives. As always, our focus remains on presenting our client's case before the Court, which is the appropriate forum for determining the issues before it."

Dr Gigaba welcomed the procedural progress and reaffirmed his commitment to the judicial process.

He said:

"I welcome the progress made by the Court today and remain fully committed to allowing the legal process to unfold through the courts. I have every confidence in our judicial system and will continue to cooperate fully with all lawful legal processes."

Dr Gigaba added:

"I would also like to express my sincere appreciation to my family, friends, colleagues and the many South Africans who have continued to support and encourage me throughout this process. Your messages of goodwill and confidence have been deeply appreciated. I remain focused on serving our country within the responsibilities entrusted to me, while allowing the legal process to take its proper course."

The legal team and the Private Office respectfully request that the judicial process be allowed to proceed without speculation or commentary on matters that will properly be determined before the Court.

No further comment will be made on the merits of the case outside the judicial process.
